HALL OF FAME WALK — Newly-elected Pro Football Hall of Fame wide receiver Terrell Owens joined the Beverly Hills Walk With the Mayor on Monday for what was perhaps the biggest turnout ever. Walkers visited Sunrise Assisted Living and the Alzheimer's Association's headquarters in Beverly Hills. Owens said that he joined the walk in honor of his grandmother Alice Black, who suffered from dementia before her death. Owens wrote on his Instagram page: "A BIG THANK YOU to the #BeverlyHills Mayor [Lili Bosse] for inviting me to participate in the Walk with the Mayor to raise awareness for #Alzheimers and #Dementia as we kicked off Celebrate Kindness Week. I had a great time." Owens, the second-leading receiver in NFL history behind only Jerry Rice, will be inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in August.
